Technical expertise alone is no longer enough.

The Leadership Excellence for Africa's Public Sector (LEAPS) program develops the strategic thinking, influence, resilience, and practical leadership capabilities needed to strengthen institutions and deliver lasting impact.

Whether you lead a ministry, department, public agency, or regional institution, LEAPS equips you with practical tools, executive support, and a continental peer network to lead transformation with confidence.

Why LEAPS?

Leadership is demonstrated through the ability to inspire people, solve complex challenges, strengthen institutions, and create sustainable change.

LEAPS is more than a leadership course.

It is an executive learning journey grounded in African realities and combining practical application, coaching, peer learning, and institutional experience.

Through LEAPS, participants learn to:

- Lead confidently through complexity and uncertainty.
- Build accountable, inclusive, and high-performing teams.
- Strengthen self-awareness, resilience, and emotional intelligence.
- Influence policy, strategy, and institutional decisions.
- Lead reform and translate vision into measurable results.
- Build partnerships and engage diverse stakeholders.

What is LEAPS?

LEAPS is a four-month executive leadership program designed by the African Capacity Building Foundation (ACBF) for current and emerging public sector leaders. Delivered through ACBF's Ubona Academy, it supports participants in strengthening their leadership capabilities, from understanding their leadership identity to leading change across institutions and systems.

Grounded in Africa's realities and informed by global practice, LEAPS provides practical tools that can be applied immediately in the workplace.

Since its launch in 2024, LEAPS has brought together public sector leaders from across Africa, building a growing community of officials equipped to strengthen institutions and lead reform. Building on this experience, the program has evolved its delivery format to better accommodate the demanding schedules of public officials while maintaining a practical and engaging learning experience.

The revised format combines self-paced learning, live facilitated sessions, executive coaching, technical seminars, peer exchange, and workplace application, allowing participants to learn while continuing to deliver on their professional responsibilities.

Who is it for?

LEAPS is designed for current and emerging leaders committed to stronger institutions and lasting public impact.

It is particularly suited to professionals working in government ministries and departments.

The program is ideal for professionals who are:

- Managing teams, departments, programs, or projects.
- Designing or implementing public policies.
- Driving reforms or influencing institutional decisions.
- Preparing for senior leadership responsibilities.

Ministries and institutions are encouraged to enrol cohorts of participants to strengthen leadership capacity, succession planning, organizational performance, and institutional transformation.

Individual learners are equally welcome to enroll and invest in their own leadership development, bringing the LEAPS experience to professionals who self-finance or seek employer sponsorship independently.

How does the program work?

LEAPS runs over four months, combining self-paced online modules with live group coaching, mentoring, and technical seminars. The flexible format is designed for senior professionals while retaining the rigour needed for meaningful leadership growth.

Duration: Four months

Format: Online, with facilitated live sessions

Languages: English and French

What will I learn?

Five progressive modules take participants from personal leadership to institutional and systemic transformation. Technical seminars connect the curriculum to emerging public sector challenges.

Module 1 – Understanding African Leadership Paradigms

Examine the values and contexts that shape leadership across Africa and develop an authentic, ethical, and transformative leadership identity.

Module 2 – Building Self-Awareness and Emotional Intelligence

Strengthen self-awareness, emotional intelligence, resilience, communication, and interpersonal effectiveness.

Module 3 – Leading High-Performing and Inclusive Teams

Learn practical approaches to motivate people, manage performance, reinforce accountability, resolve conflict, and foster inclusive workplaces.

Module 4 – Driving Strategic Change within Organizations

Build the skills to lead organizational change, overcome resistance, align people around shared goals, and translate strategy into results.

Module 5 – Engaging Stakeholders and Driving Systemic Transformation

Learn to build partnerships, influence stakeholders, negotiate competing interests, and facilitate collaboration across institutions and systems.

Expert-led technical seminars connect learning to current public sector priorities, including:

- Governance and institutional effectiveness.
- Leadership during crisis and uncertainty.
- Strategic negotiation and influence.
- Sustainable public sector management.

What You Will Gain?

Successful participants receive a Certificate of Completion from ACBF's Ubora Academy, as well as:

- A stronger leadership mindset and greater confidence.
- Practical tools for immediate workplace application.
- Enhanced decision-making and change-management capabilities.

Program fee: USD 1,500 per participant. The fee covers access to all online modules, live facilitated sessions, group coaching and mentoring, technical seminars, learning materials, and certification upon successful completion.
